

LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18.2)

Out of bounds is defined by the course-side edge of any wall, fence, fence posts or white stakes bounding the course. The boundary to the left of the 12th hole is defined by white posts or marked trees. A ball is out of bounds when it is beyond the pathway defining the boundary of the course by the Club House and Hotel. The pathway between the 9th & 18th greens does not define out of bounds when playing either hole.

2. PENALTY AREAS (RULE 17)

Red penalty areas are marked by red stakes or lines. Yellow penalty areas are marked with yellow stakes or lines. If a penalty area has not been marked by colour it is treated as a red penalty area. The red penalty area on left hand side of the 10th hole defined on only one side extends to infinity.

3. STATUS OF PRACTICE PUTTING GREEN

The practice putting green located in between the 1st tee and 9th green is a wrong green and relief must be taken under Rule 13.1f.

4. ANIMAL DUNG

At the player's option, dung from swans, ducks and coots may be treated either as a loose impediment that may be removed under Rule 15.1, or ground under repair from which relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.

5. ALL ROADS AND PATHS TREATED AS OBSTRUCTIONS

All roads and paths on the course are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.

6. PRACTISING BEFORE ROUNDS

A player must not practise on the competition course before or between rounds. This includes chipping to the side of or onto the practice putting green. **Penalty for breach of Local Rule - see Rule 5.2.**

7. METHODS FOR STOPPING AND RESUMING PLAY

A suspension of play for a dangerous situation will be signalled by two long bursts of the klaxon. All other suspensions will be signalled by two short bursts of the klaxon. In either case, resumption of play will be signalled by a single burst. See Rule 5.7b.

8. PACE OF PLAY POLICY (RULE 5.6B(3))

Please see the separate detailed Pace of Play Policy.

Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the General Penalty. A full list of club local rules is available on the club notice board.

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

If medical help is needed immediately please telephone 999 and call the club on 01704 835428. Club staff will ensure that a qualified first-aider equipped with First Aid box and Defibrillator attend the incident as quickly as possible.

GENERAL COURSE RULES

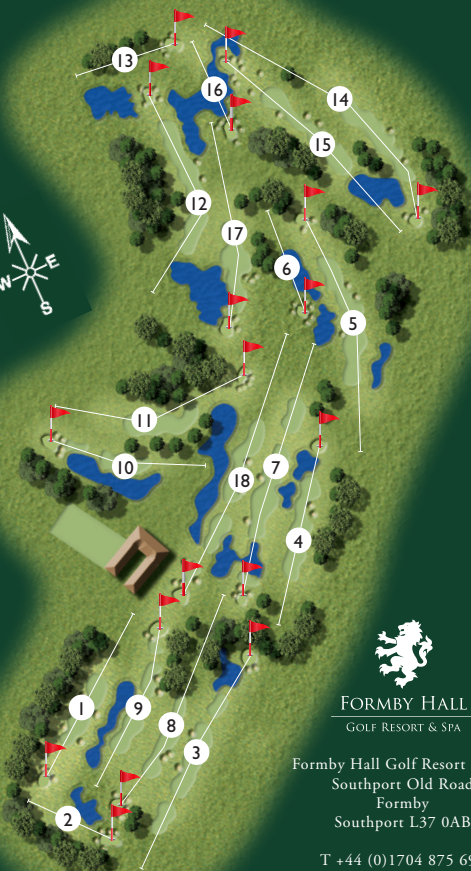
PACE OF PLAY: We ask all golfers to play without delay and to support prompt pace of play. Please adopt "Ready Golf" whenever possible and allow faster groups to play through.

CARE OF THE COURSE: Repair all pitch-marks and divots. Rakes should be placed in the middle of bunkers after use. Please put all litter in bins. Trolleys and buggies must not be taken onto tees or near greens.

DRESS CODE: Strictly NO denim jeans, tracksuits or combats. Tailored shorts only, NO football style shorts. Shirts must always be tucked in and be collared. Football or rugby style shirts and tracksuit or hooded tops are strictly NOT permitted. Golf shoes must be worn; metal spikes are not permitted.

MOBILE PHONES: Mobile phones must be switched off or turned to silent vibrate both on the course and in the clubhouse.

Anyone found not following these rules will be asked to leave the course immediately without refund.

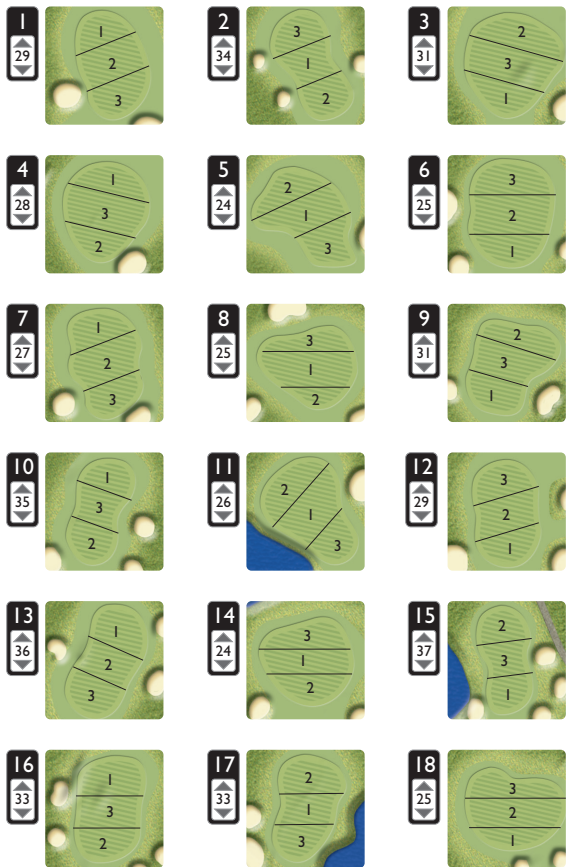


THE OLD COURSE
