

LOCAL RULES FOR PAR 3 COURSE

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27-1)

Beyond any fence, or hedge defining the boundary of the course, or any line of white stakes. The Clubhouse and surrounding area, including the putting green and car park.

2. Water Hazards (Rule 26)

Water hazards are identified by yellow lines or stakes. Lateral water hazards are identified by red lines or stakes, sleepers forming the boundaries of some of the hazards are to be treated as part of the hazard.

3. Stones in Bunkers

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

4. Fixed Sprinkler Heads

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2.

5. Immovable Obstructions

All Astroturf, tarmac, concrete, shale or wooden bridges and pathways are immovable obstructions, all safety netting is also deemed an immovable obstruction, and interference by them relief may be taken under Rule 24-2.

6. Ground Under Repair

If a player's ball lies in an area marked as "Ground Under Repair" or such an area of "Ground Under Repair" interferes with the player's stance or the area of intended swing, the player must take relief in accordance with Rule 25-1.

7. Burrowing Animals

A ball lying in an area affected by a burrowing animal, or if such an area interferes with the player's stance or the area of intended swing, they may take relief in accordance with Rule 25-1.

8. Order of Play

Players MUST NOT start the hole until the group in front have cleared the green, and are also clear of the intended line of play.

Course Rules

Pace of Play: Play without delay and allow faster groups to play through.

Care of the Course: Repair all pitch-marks and divots. Rake bunkers after use and put all litter in bins.

Dress Code: Strictly NO denim jeans, tracksuits or combats. Tailored shorts only, NO football style shorts. Collared shirts only and must be tucked into trousers or shorts at all times. Football or rugby style shirts and tracksuit/hooded tops are strictly NOT permitted. Golf shoes only are allowed on the Old Course but suitable training shoes may be worn on The PGA Par 3 course.

Mobile Phones: Mobile phones must be switched off or turned to silent /vibrate both on the course and in the clubhouse.

STRICTLY NO trolleys allowed on teeing areas.

Please be aware of moving cars when crossing the road to access the course.

Please be aware at all times of moving cars and pedestrians using the main road when playing the course.

Anyone found not following these rules will be asked to leave the course immediately without refund.
