White Wine

Grillo, Lascari, Sicily

A distinctive, floral bouquet, is followed by a fresh, but surprisingly rich, palate with plenty of citrus and tropical fruit flavours and excellent balancing acidity.

Rocheburg Chenin Blanc, The Cape, South Africa

A refreshing, zesty, unoaked Chenin Blanc, packed full of fresh tropical fruit flavours of pineapple, peach and apple. Very versatile.

Viognier, Vin de Pays d'Oc Rothschilds, France

Bright golden straw colour. An aromatic wine with floral aromas of apricot blossom and vanilla. The palate has similarly ripe, exotic flavours, combined with a touch of honey. Dry, but rich and opulent.

Oyster Shack, Sauvignon Blanc, Chile

Pinot Grigio, La Casada, Italy

Bright, refreshing Pinot Grigio from the Veneto, with delicate aromatics and much more weight and character than you normally get at this price level.

Brown Brothers Everton, Chardonnay, Australia

Sassy unwooded, dry white. Delicate aromas of peach, apricot and almonds. On the palate - fresh, crisp and lively with attractive fruit flavours.

Valserrano Rioja Blanco, Spain

A zingy fruit cocktail: gooseberry, lime, guava and lemon. Fresh tropical fruit is balanced by creamy oak. A well-balanced, impressive white Rioja.

Whitehaven Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand

Delicious varietal flavours, excellent body and weight. A richer style of Sauvignon - full of ripe gooseberry and grapefruit aromas. Great concentration.

Chablis, AC, France

A good example of this world famous white wine - steely dry with delicate, minerally Chardonnay fruit. Fresh and lively on the palate. A focused palate is followed by a persistent rich lemony finish.

Albarino, Terra D'Ouro, Rias Biaxis

Typically, wines made from Albariño are very aromatic, often described as having scents of almonds or almond paste, apples, peaches, citrus, and flowers or grass. Albariño wines are particularly suited to seafood due to their bracing acidity (Jancis Robinson calls it "razor-sharp.")

Chablis Fourchaumes 1 Cr AC, Le Manoir

Fourchaume is the second largest premier cru site of the Chablis district, producing wines which reflect the true essence of the region. Full bodied, rich, with great depth.

Red Wine

Nero d'Avola, Lascari, Sicily

A very characterful fruit-driven red, which is soft, approachable and easy to drink. A great food wine, but also ideal on its own. Ripe strawberry and blueberry fruit with delicate overtones of vanilla.

Oyster Shack Merlot, Chile

A dark purple red colour with a strong, intense ripe blackberry and plum aroma that delivers a spicy, rich full-bodied red wine with pepper hints on the plate.

Rothschilds Pinot Noir, France

Very perfumed for a Southern French Pinot Noir, with aromas of wild strawberry, toasted oak and menthol. Richly ripe thanks to the warm southern sunshine, yet very elegant and smooth in texture.

Azabache Rioja, Tempranillo, Spain

Pure unadulterated fruit that is fresh, juicy and with great overtones of cloves and spices. The wine displays soft, round jammy red fruit-lip-smacking.

Brown Brothers Everton, Shiraz/Cabernet, Australia

Full-bodied, full-flavoured red blend from one of Australia's most innovative wine-makers. Ripe red berry fruit, violets, subtle oak and a slightly gamey character.

Dark, smooth and richly fruity with generous ripe mulberry and plum flavours.

Brown Brothers Limited Release Heathcotes Shiraz, Australia

Liquid Aussie charm, a big softy with a warm, hearty welcome. Plummy, chewy fruit complemented with a solid vanilla backbone from the wood maturation. Balanced and harmonious.

Marques de Riscal, Rioja, Spain

Classic wine. Fragrance of morello cherries, combined with aromas of toasty oak. Intense garnet red colour. Fruit is well balanced by subtle tannins and acidity. Smooth, mellow finish.

Fleurie AC Pierre Gerfaut Beaujolais, France

The most famous of the 10 crus of Beaujolais, the sister wine to Brouilly offering a more elegant, almost feminine style, which seems sleek in nature.

Baron Philippe de Rothschilds St Emilion, France

Juicy, plummy Merlot fruit. Soft, smooth texture, backed up by good acidity and fine tannins.

Valpolicella Amarone Classico DOC Botter, Italy

Made from semi-dried grapes to give a colour and a dry, but powerful, Port-like flavour. From vineyards to the north of Verona, east of Bardolino. Rich, lingering, spicy flavour. Strong and powerful yet smooth in texture.

Pinot Grigio Rosata

With soft floral flavours on the nose and palate this copper coloured Rose wine exhibits a dry, refreshing and pleasantly smooth finish.
