## OCAL RULES

I. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18.2) Out of bounds is defined by the course-side edge of any wall, fence, fence posts or white stakes bounding the course. The boundary to the left
of the 12th hole is defined by white posts or marked trees. A ball is out of bounds when it is beyond the pathway defining the boundary of the course by the Club House and Hotel. The pathway between the 9th \& 18th greens does not define out of bounds when playing either hole.
2. PENALTY AREAS (RULE 17) Red penalty areas are marked by red stakes or lines. Yellow penalty areas are marked with yellow stakes or lines. If a penalty area has not been marked area. The red penalty area on left hand side of the 10th hole defined on only one side extends to infinity.

## PUTTING GREEN

The practice putting green located in between the Ist tee and 9 th green is a wrong green and relief must be taken under Rule 13. If.

## 4. ANIMAL DUNG

At the player's option, dung from swans, ducks and coots may be treated ither as a loose impediment that round under repair from which relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.
5. ALL ROADS AND PATHS
TREATED AS OBSTRUCTIONS

treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.I.
6. PRACTISING BEFORE ROUNDS A player must not practise on the competition course before or between rounds. This includes chipping to the side of or onto the practice putting green. Penalty for breach of Local Rule - see Rule 5.2.
7. METHODS FOR STOPPING AND RESUMING PLAY A suspension of play for a dangerous long bursts of the klaxon. All other uspensions will be signalled by two short bursts of the klaxon. In either case, resumption of play will be signalled by a single burst. See Rule 5.7b.
